




Woden Valley State League Hat Tournament Saturday 4th February 2017



As part of the Woden Valley Soccer Club (WVSC) open day the club is pleased to announce the State League Hat Tournament will be held on 4 February 2017. This is a social event for returning and new WVSC State League players, WVSC U18s teams and affiliated teams (NPL and community teams that train at Mawson). The tournament is held on and also supports World Cancer Day.

Objective: The tournament is a six-a-side social football tournament and aims to bring together players from our returning and new State League, Junior League U18 teams, affiliated and community teams and players. It is open to all members of the football community, men and women; however players must turn 16 or older in 2016 to participate and non-registered players must also pay insurance to participate. It will include rounds of social games for existing teams followed by a Hat tournament format for the final round (where teams are formed by drawing names from a hat). There will be a short presentation and barbeque for players following the final round.

- * Entry is by Gold Coin donation for WVSC registered and affiliated players.
- * \$12 per player for insurance for non-Capital Football players (i.e. Players that did NOT compete in the CF Winter Comp or Futsal Comps in 2016).

Competition Rules:

- Games are 15 minutes each way with a five minute half time break.
- Six player's aside (including one goalkeeper) and a maximum of five substitutes.
- Teams must nominate at least 8 players.

Date: Saturday 4rd February 2016

(Nominations open 25 January and close 2 February)

Location: Mawson Playing Fields

Time: Games start at 3:30pm and finish by 8:00pm

Cost: Gold Coin Donation per player *

Your donation will support World Cancer Day, (Movember and the Australian Breast Cancer Network)

- **Shin guards are compulsory.** Players will not be permitted on the field without shin guards. If you are injured without shin guards you are not covered by the insurance.
- Teams to provided own shirts (bibs will be provided) – goalkeepers must wear a different shirt/Bib or Gloves.

- Regular football rules apply (including the adherence to the FFA Code of Conduct*), with two exceptions:
 - No slide tackles - Slide tackles will result in an indirect free kick for the opposition.
 - No offside
- A player issued a YELLOW CARD must leave the field for 5 minutes and cannot be replaced. A player issued a RED CARD will be required to leave the field for the remainder of the game and may face a one match ban and possible further disciplinary action.

- Referees will be provided on a roster basis. These referees can caution and send players off.
- All teams are requested to assist in putting the goals and nets up when they play the first match and taking them down and packing them up after the last games. Goals can be collected from the Containers and must be returned to the containers as well.
- Teams are required to provide a match ball for use each week.

IMPORTANT POINTS:

- Please remember that this is a **SOCIAL competition** and should be played that way. Teams or players may be excluded for the remainder of the season for any indiscretions during the competition.
- Teams will be grouped into divisions depending on preference and ability – on the Nomination Form, teams will be asked to nominate which division they would like to play in – however teams may be graded to provide a similar level of competition and increase enjoyment of the competition.
- Referees will provide the competition coordinators with end results.

CAPITAL FOOTBALL REQUIREMENT

- All football players and officials participating in Capital Football affiliated competitions are required to have an FFA Number.
- Players that have **NOT** competed in winter football/Futsal competitions in 2016 will need to register for an FFA number and pay the **\$12** insurance cost.

- Once they have generated their FFA number, ensure that the team manager includes the details on the *Nomination Form*.

Nomination Process:

To nominate a team, team managers should:

- Provide a COMPLETED *Nomination Form (attached below)* with all details and submit it to partnerships@wvsc.org.au in an email marked: *TEAM NOMINATION: [Team Name]*;
- The organiser will email you to accept your nomination. Once you are notified that your nomination has been ACCEPTED, then:
 - i. Get each players to fill out the *Indemnity Form* (which will be emailed to you with your acceptance);
 - ii. Provide all signed *Indemnity Forms* to the organiser on the first night of competition.


