1 # Wanderers Development Academy, Term 4 2018

The Term 4 Woden-Weston Football Club (WWFC) Wanderers Development Academy is for girls aged 9-12 years from across the community clubs, in particular WVSC and WMFC, and focuses on developing the core skills in attack and defence, while using the game as the teacher. 2 # Wanderers Super Summer Sixes, Term 4 2018

The Term 4 Woden-Weston Football Club (WWFC) Wanderers Super Summer Sixes is a youth based six-a-side social football competition held at the Waramanga Ovals on Wednesday nights for 10 weeks during October to December.

When: Every Wednesday night – 10, 17, 24, 31 Oct; 7, 14, 21, 28 Nov; 5, 12 19 Dec.

Where: Waramanga (see map on website)

Who:

- Mixed Junior 12-13 Boys & 12-14 Girls
- Six players a side (including one goalkeeper) and a maximum of five substitutes.
- Teams must nominate at least 8 players but no more than 11.

• 'Home' team to provide a referee.

Session Times:

- Game times TBA.
- Games are 20 minutes each way with a five minute half time break.

Dress & Equipment:

- **Shin guards are compulsory.** Players will not be permitted on the field without shin guards. If you are injured without shin guards you are not covered by the insurance.
- Teams must wear the same shirt, same shorts and same coloured socks except goalkeepers who must wear a different shirt and can wear the same or different shorts and/or socks.
- Teams are responsible for providing bibs when there is a colour clash with the 'home' team.
- All players are required to bring at least one water bottle each.

Cost/Fees: \$800 per team (8-11 players), non-CF registered players add \$12 for insurance. Players playing CF winter comps or Futsal are covered.

Registration and Payment:

- Nominations now open and close Fri 28 Sep 18.
 Nomination Process: To nominate a team, clubs/team managers are to provide a COMPLETED <u>Nomination Form</u> with all details and submit it via email to <u>lightning@wwfc.org.au</u>.
- The organiser will then email you to accept your nomination and provide details for payment.
- **Consent Forms:** By entering the tournament, all coaches/managers and players agree to abide by the tournament rules.

3 # Woden Valley Street Soccer, Term 4 2018

The Term 4 Woden Valley Soccer Club (WVSC) Street Soccer is a **mixed social competition** for footballers of **all levels focusing on small sided games for enjoyment and fun, with no coaching,** for WVSC junior players during the warmer months. The program is held at Mawson Playing Fields on Wednesday nights for 8 weeks during October to December.

When: Every Wednesday night from 17th October (for 8 weeks).

Where: Mawson Playing Fields.

Who:

- Open to girls (and boys) of all levels and divisions.
- The emphasis is on involvement, fun and enjoyment. There are no fixed teams, players arrive on the day and are sorted into groups ideally of 5 vs 5 but that may depend on numbers. There are no referees but there will be game supervisors. There is no coaching; game supervisors may guide/encourage players to be involved.

Session Times:

• GU10-12s (in a mixed social competition) – 7.00-7.45pm.

Dress & Equipment:

- Shin guards are compulsory. Players will not be permitted on the field without shin guards. If you are injured without shin guards you are not covered by the insurance.
- All players are required to bring at least one water bottle each.

Cost/Fees: A gold coin donation (to help cover field hire) for 2018 WVSC registered players, or \$12 for players not registered with WVSC.

5 # Tuggeranong Summer Sixes, Term 4 2018

The Term 4 Tuggeranong United Football Club (TUFC) is a social competition for footballers of all levels. The program is held at Wanniassa District Playing Fields on Friday nights for 10 weeks during October to December.

When: Every Friday night from 12th October to 14th December 2018 (includes **9** round games and one week of finals – if applicable).

Where: Wanniassa District Playing Fields, Hyland Place (off Wheeler Crescent)

Who:

- Junior open and girls' only divisions are age grouped tournaments ranging from under 10 to under 12, sub-divided into U10 and U12 age groupings.
- Ultimately, divisional organisation depends on the number of teams entering in each age group. However, TUFC will be endeavouring to have as many girl only grades as possible. This is dependent on numbers but where ever possible this will occur.
- Six players a side (including one goalkeeper) and a maximum of five substitutes.
- Each team can list up to ten (10) players on the match card all players must be registered in the team they play for.

Session Times:

First match at 5.30pm and other matches will follow at ~50 minute intervals.

- Times may be adjusted depending on the final number of age divisions and number of teams within each age division.
- Two periods of 20 minutes each with a 5 minute break for half time.

Dress & Equipment:

- Shin guards are compulsory. Players will not be permitted on the field without shin guards. If you are injured without shin guards you are not covered by the insurance.
- Teams must wear the same shirt, same shorts and same coloured socks except goalkeepers who must wear a different shirt and can wear the same or different shorts and/or socks.
- Each shirt of each teams strip must have a number at least 150 mm high to enable the unique identification of each player in a team.
- Teams are responsible for providing bibs when there is a colour clash with the 'home' team.
- All players are required to bring at least one water bottle each.

Cost/Fees: \$550 per team (6-10 players), non-CF registered players add \$12 for insurance. Players playing CF winter comps or Futsal are covered.

Registration and Payment:

- Nominations now open and close Sun 07 Oct 18.
- All players are required to register in the TUFC Summer Sixes 2018 packages through MyFootballClub following the instructions on the website. All individual payments of fees must be made to the team manager who will organise to pay the team fee in full prior to the first round of the competition.
