Match Operations

Entry and Exits

- Families encouraged to use nearest car park to their field.
- Players and family are asked to:
 - **ENTER** the fields from the left of the clubhouse (when approaching from the Beasley Street carpark) and
 - **LEAVE** from the other side when using the Beasley Street carpark
- Anyone entering fields from other locations is asked to maximise social distancing.

Spectators

- Many large spectator areas are available to allow for increased social distancing.

Canteens

- The canteen and coffee cart will operate with:
 - Increased cleaning frequency,
 - Hand sanitiser available
 - Social distancing markers
- Water available for filling of bottles, with hand sanitiser to be used before and after

Amenities

- Toilet block open, with soap and water to be used for cleaning hands
- Change rooms closed

Accessing Mawson Fields from Beasley Street carpark

ENTRY PROCESS

Please bring players to the Mawson Playing Fields by the left hand side of the carpark as you enter (see the **Green** arrow)

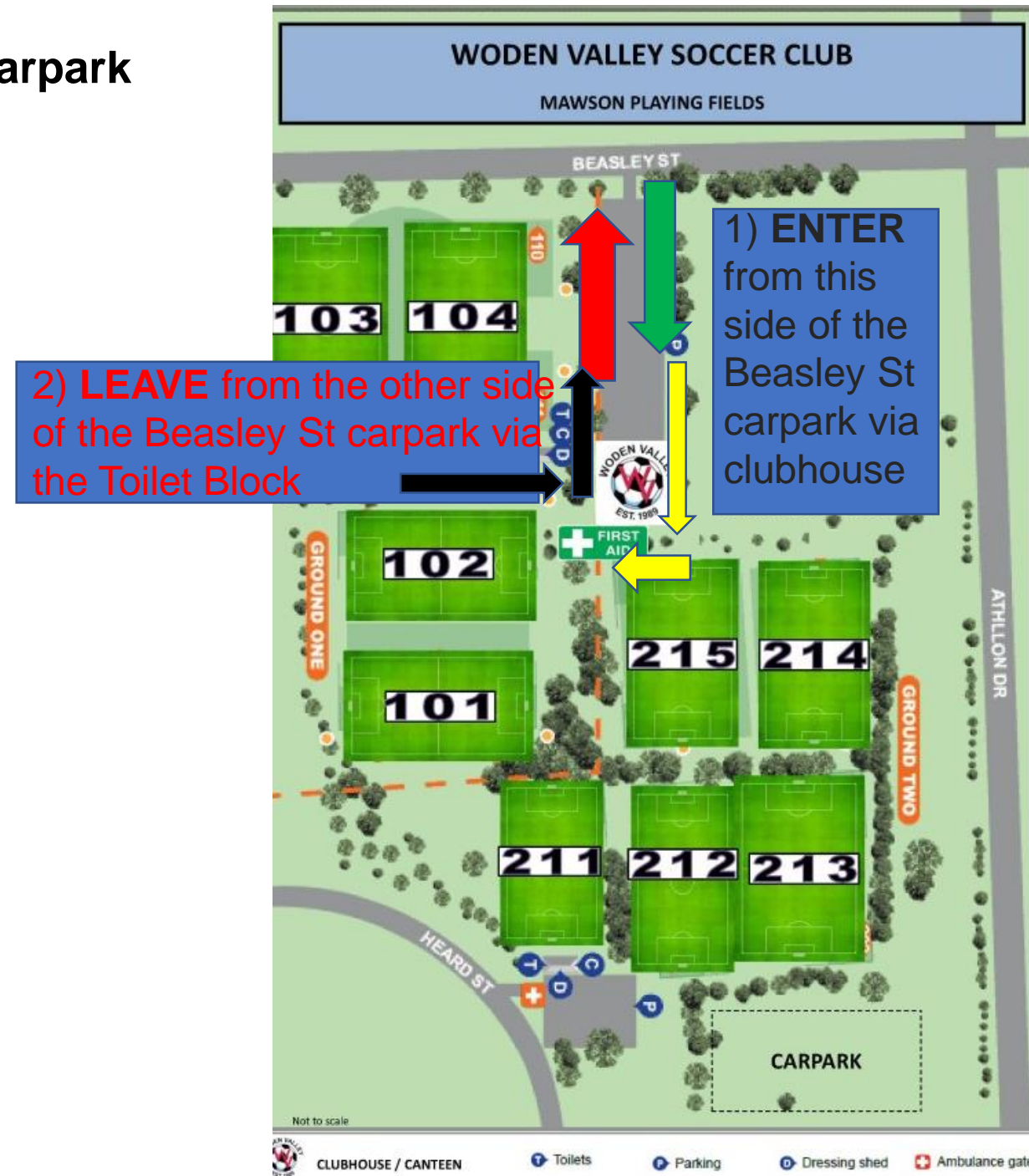
- Please walk down the left hand side driveway and to the left and front of the clubhouse, heading towards **field 215**.
- see the **Yellow** arrows

EXIT PROCESS

When leaving, squads should go to the right hand side of the carpark near the Toilet Block near **field 104**

- see the **Black** arrow
- After being collected, vehicles should leave via the right hand side of the carpark (see Red arrow)

Parents and family: please practice social distancing when arriving, spectating and leave.





PeeWees & MiniRoos Field Locations

- Players and family are asked to:
 - **ENTER** the fields from the left of the clubhouse (when approaching from the Beasley Street carpark) and
 - **LEAVE** from the other side when using the Beasley Street carpark
- Anyone entering fields from other locations is asked to maximise social distancing.

General Precautions

Attendance

- Participants (including players, parents, coaches, referees, volunteers) are not to return to matches if they:

Hygiene

- Bins are provided around the venue
