General Precautions

Attendance

Participants and spectators should not attend training or matches, if in the past 14 days they have:

- ▶ Felt unwell
- ▶ Have any flu-like symptoms;
- ▶ Travelled internationally
- ▶ Travelled to Victoria
- ▶ Travelled to any of the reported case locations listed on the NSW Health Website
- ▶ Been exposed to a person with COVID-19
- ▶ Been tested for COVID-19 and have not yet received the results (please see COVID-19 Protocol)
- ▶ Have a medical condition or at an age that puts you in the high risk category

Hygiene

- ▶ Ensure spaces, surfaces and objects at each venue are regularly cleaned;
- ▶ Promote regular and thorough hand washing by club and team officials and participants;
- ▶ No sharing of drink bottles
- ▶ Ensure bins are provided around the venue

Behaviour

- ▶ Cover mouth and nose with a tissue or your elbow (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze;
- ▶ If using tissues, place them directly in the bins provided;
- ▶ No spitting at any time



What is permitted during Match Play

The following is permitted at the venue and during match play;

- ▶ Full competitive and non-competitive matches are permitted within the normal Laws of the Game
- ▶ Where possible, players should come ready to play
- ▶ Play only – get in, play, get out
- ▶ Social activities when games have concluded are discouraged. Club meetings must be limited to essential gatherings and within the government's guidelines
- ▶ Spectator areas to meet gathering restrictions (In ACT no more than 200 per venue (excluding staff and in NSW no more than 500 per venue)
- ▶ Continue to encourage limitation of spectators (no more than 2 spectators per player)
- ▶ Promote physical distancing of 1.5 metres between spectators
- ▶ Canteens and BBQ's are permitted in line with relevant government requirements.



What is NOT permitted during Match Play

The following is NOT permitted at the venue and during match play;

- ▶ Handshakes before and after the match
- ▶ Team huddles and high fives
- ▶ Multiplayer goal celebrations
- ▶ Spitting
- ▶ Sharing of equipment including drink bottles, towels, shin pads and bibs
- ▶ Use of changerooms



Match Operations at Venue

Entry and Exits

- ENTER the fields from the left of the clubhouse (when approaching from the Beasley Street carpark) and
- LEAVE from the other side when using the Beasley Street carpark
- Anyone entering fields from other locations is asked to maximise social distancing.

Spectators

- Many large spectator areas are available to allow for increased social distancing.



Match Operations at Venue

Canteen

The canteen will operate with:

- Increased cleaning frequency,
- Hand sanitiser available
- Social distancing markers

Amenities

- Must abide by 1 person per 4m²
- Toilets will be open for use
- Toilet block open, with soap and water to be used for cleaning hands



Match Operations at Venue

Changerooms can be used for:

- Use by referees, only for the number of people permitted on the signage displayed outside the changeroom
- Use for medical services and support, only for the number of people permitted on the signage displayed outside the changeroom

Changerooms cannot be used for:

- Teams to prepare for a match
- Coaches to discuss tactics among themselves
- Coaches to address players pre-match, at half-time, or post-match



VENUE MAP – Mawson Playing Fields

ENTRY PROCESS

Please bring players to the Mawson Playing Fields by the left hand side of the carpark as you enter

(see the **Green** arrow)

- Please walk down the left hand side driveway and to the left and front of the clubhouse, heading towards **field 215**.
- see the **Yellow** arrows

EXIT PROCESS

When leaving, squads should go to the right hand side of the carpark near the Toilet Block near **field 104**

- see the **Black** arrow
- After being collected, vehicles should leave via the right hand side of the carpark (see Red arrow)
