## **REGISTRATION INFORMATION**

## 1. Junior Players (non-NPLY)

- Under 10 to Under 18 players placement sessions (trials) for those aspiring to play in Division 1 and 2 teams (U10 -18) commence February (<u>Trial Details</u>). Registration is required to participate. Players who wish to be placed with friendship groups, i.e. not in a Division 1 or 2 teams are not required t o attend trials. Whole team nominations are encouraged for non-graded teams. Please email details to admin@wvsc.org.au
- Under 7 to Under 9 players please register early to assist with the formation of teams. <u>After 1<sup>st</sup></u> <u>March, registrations will only be accepted if spaces are available.</u>
- Under 5- 6 players there are no set teams to form. Full details are here Peewees

#### 2. National Premier League Youth (NPLY) U13-18 Players

This applies to the player's selected from NPLY trials in 2020.

#### 3. Adult Players

WVSC have teams in Women's State League, Men's State League and Men's Masters, for players over 18 years of age. If you are interested in joining any of these teams, please email <u>admin@wvsc.org.au</u> for further details.

## 4. Age Groups Eligibility

- Junior players may play one age group older than their true age group (i.e., 'up a year'), and girls wishing to play in boys' competitions can play one year younger than their true age group (i.e., 'down a year'). If wishing to play 'up' or 'down', email <u>admin@wvsc.org.au</u> the player's name, date of birth, and the age group in which he/she wishes to play.
- Under-6 is a two-year age group for children born in 2015 or 2016 (i.e., turning 5 or 6 in 2021). *Children born 2017 are too young and will not be registered*.
- We encourage girls to play in all-Girls teams, but they may play in mixed (Open) teams. We assume female players wish to play in an all-Girls team unless advised otherwise by email (admin@wvsc.org.au). Under no circumstances will a male player be permitted to play in an otherwise all-Girls team.

#### 6. Team Preference and Formation

- **Peewees (U5-6s)**, players are not allocated to set teams. You will be able to arrange for friends to play together informally on a Saturday.
- Under 7 to Under 9 age groups: age coordinators do their best to meet team preferences and requests. However, (i) late registration may reduce our ability to do this, and (ii) members of a 2020 team have preference over players who are new to WVSC, provided they register by 1<sup>st</sup>
  March. Teams are based on school and friendships groups as far as possible, considering the above.
- Under 10 to Under 18 age groups: more proficient players are graded into Division 1 and 2 teams based on player placement sessions in February. Other players are placed in Division 3 teams based on school or friendship groups. Under 10 and 11 teams play 9 v 9 with 11 players; under 12-18 teams play 11 v 11 with 13-16 players.

#### 7. WVSC Merchandise and Clothing

WVSC shorts (sky blue) and socks (sky blue with two red bands and red club logo) are available from our endorsed supplier *Intersport*, Whyalla Street (near the intersection with Newcastle Street) Fyshwick.

Boots and shin-pads are compulsory and are also available from Intersports.

WVSC Merchandise is available from the WVSC Clubhouse during the season. WVSC supplies players' shirts for the season.

#### 8. Coaches, Managers and Volunteers

- Each WVSC team needs a coach and a manager. Most will need to be parents. Your offer to coach a manage a team will be greatly appreciated. We offer support and coach courses are available through Capital Football.
